## **Home of Divine Mercy Radio Operations (see photo above)**

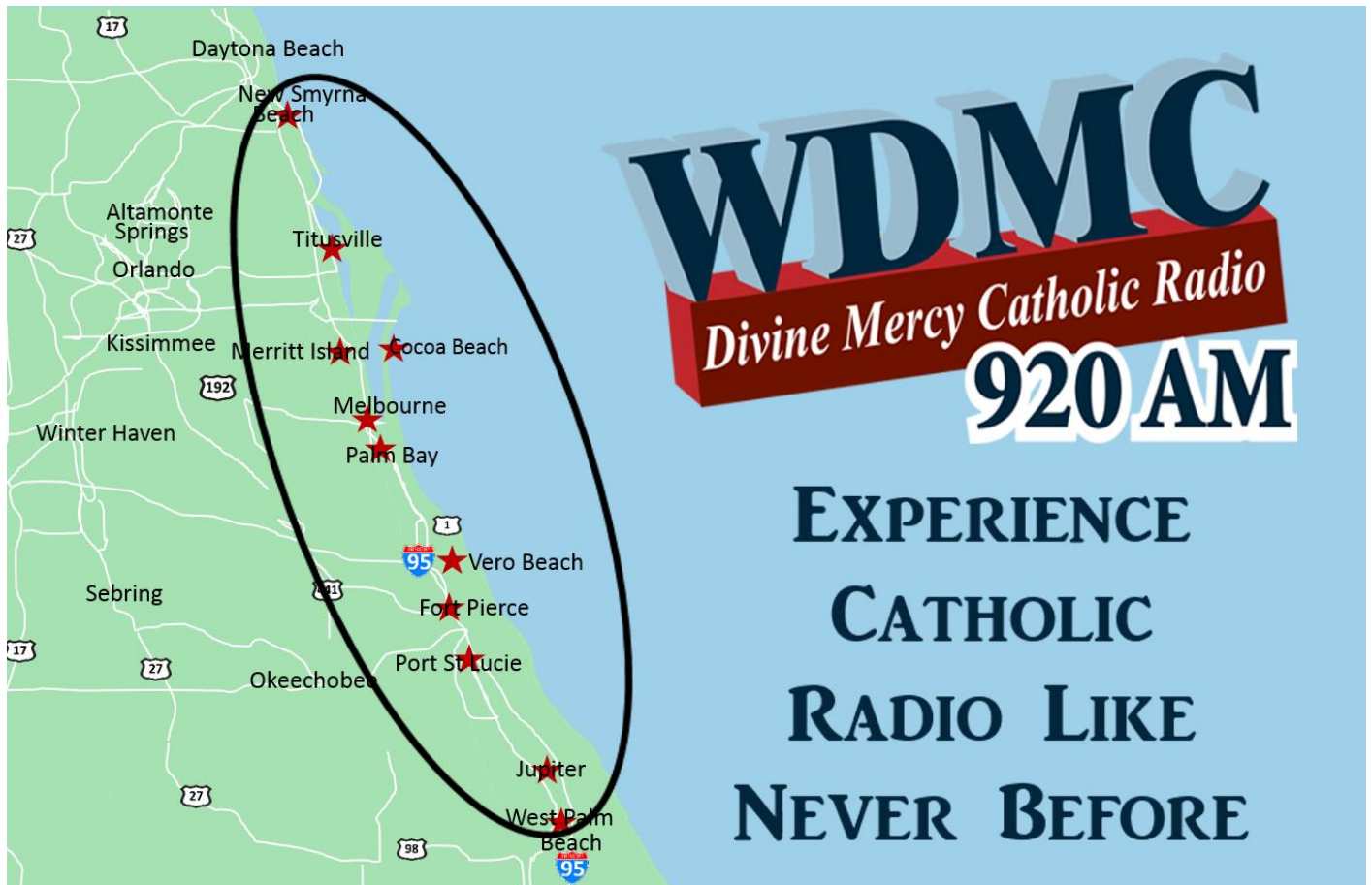
WDMC has moved to our new radio station facilities (studio, offices and chapel) located at 2020 W. Eau Gallie Blvd. Suite 103. Our new location is at the northeast corner of Croton and Eau Gallie Blvd. This location is home of Divine Mercy Radio operations.



## **Divine Mercy Radio is now transmitting full power from our new Remote Transmitter Site**

This is the site where the broadcast equipment and a 300 sq. ft. Transmitter building is located. The site is approximately 1 mile west of I-95 on the Eau Gallie Blvd extension.

This photo shows the control units placed alongside each of the 3 new towers. They are connected via various cables and wire buried in trenches leading back to the transmission building. Metal poles are for the chain link fences surrounding the towers bases and all guy wire anchors.



## **WDMC Coverage Area**

**Now 8,000 watts with 1.3 million potential listeners**

Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> was a very special day for Divine Mercy Radio as we broadcast for the first time from our new towers. Many years in the planning and almost 2 years to construct, this new 3-tower array means a strong and clear sound for current as well as future listeners living in areas not previously covered by WDMC or any other Catholic radio station.
